•	Priscilla and Aquila are said to have "risked their" in order to aid Paul (Rom. 16:4)
•	Epaphroditus is said by Paul to have "he almost died for the work of Christ, He risked his life to make up for the help you yourselves could not give me." (Phil. 2:30).
