## UNDERSTANDING STRONGHOLDS

For though we live in the world, we do not wage war as the world does. The weapons we fight with are not the weapons of the world. On the contrary, they have divine power to demolish strongholds. We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ. 2 Corinthians 10:3-5

Paul describes a spiritual stronghold as being attitudes, knowledge, philosophies, teachings, and mindsets that oppose the knowledge of God.

In your anger do not sin. Do not let the sun go down while you're still angry, and do not give the devil a foothold. Ephesians 4:27

We need to take thoughts captive that cause us to believe lies about God and yourself.
