## Things to Do Before Coming to Class:

- Attend the water baptismal class that is scheduled before the baptism. Sunday Morning 1<sup>st</sup> Service - Baptismal Class 8:15am Sunday Morning 2<sup>nd</sup> Service - Baptismal Class 10:00am Sunday Evening Night of Worship and Water Baptism - Baptismal class 6:00pm Please note-Baptismal classes are held in the Senior Pastor's office unless otherwise indicated.

  - Children 12 and younger read Water Baptism God's Ordinance
  - Adults study the questions included in this packet
- 3. Fill out Water Baptismal Profile Card and bring to class

## For Your Consideration:

The following are ways your baptismal could be extra meaningful to you:

- Invite family and/or friends to witness your baptism. They would be free to stand alongside you as you are baptized.
- Because the scriptures do not require a pastor or specific leader in the church to baptize people, we would give you the option of having a parent, spiritual mentor, or someone else who has had a significant influence in your spiritual life baptize you. It could be a real special blessing for you and the person who baptizes you. If you would rather have a pastor baptize you, we would be honored.
- Share your personal testimony. The congregation is so encouraged to hear testimonies about people's salvation and walk with Christ. We encourage you to do so, but it is not a requirement.
- Picture taking is permissible.
